

Looking for future culinary stars

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(Vancouver) – Celebrating its sixth year as Canada’s largest search to find the future stars of the culinary scene, the Hawksworth Young Chef Scholarship 2018 (a Canadian non-profit culinary foundation) competition is officially open for applications. Established in 2013, the Foundation encourages aspiring, young chefs from across Canada by giving them the chance to showcase their cooking skills in front of a panel of the country’s most esteemed chefs and critics. The competition winner will take home the grand prize of \$10,000 and a placement at one of the top restaurant’s in the world. Regional heats will be held across the country through May in Calgary, Vancouver, Montreal and Toronto. The Scholarship’s founder and owner, Chef David Hawksworth says, “I’m so grateful to the judges and culinary community for their generous support. In the past five years, we’ve been amazed at the level of excellence these young chefs bring to the table and are sure this year will prove no different,” says Hawksworth. The Final competition will be held in October, when one deserving chef will take home the grand prize and the bragging rights of being Canada’s top young chef. Deadline for applications is Monday April 2, 2018.
